3. Curriculum Vitae

4. Personal Statement

This statement should be no longer than one page and should outline your reasons for applying for this course and what you hope to gain from it. You need to include a brief statement concerning your suitability for studying in a Problem Based Learning program.

5. Knowledge of the work of occupational therapists.

Applicants are required to provide evidence of knowledge of the work of occupational therapists, for example the roles they undertake. This may take the form of:

- a) Documented work experience with an occupational therapists; or
- b) A one page report of your understanding of the work of occupational therapists from sources such as personal communication (for example, from occupational therapists or consumers of occupational therapy services), textbooks, websites. All sources should be referenced.

6. Evidence First Aid Certificate (Level 2), required by the time of enrolment.

7. Confidential referees

Three (3) confidential referee letters: to comment on personal characteristics, and/or academic ability (Head of Department or lecturer). One reference should be from an Occupational Therapist or other health professional.

8. Other Selection Information

Please provide the Selection Officer with any other information you may deem as relevant to this application.
