OHS SMOKING POLICY

Purpose/ objectives	To define areas where smoking is prohibited in the interests of health and safety of persons.
Scope/ Application	All University buildings, vehicles and enclosed walkways All University staff, contractors, visitors and students
Policy Statement	<p>The University is concerned for the health and comfort of its staff and students in respect to exposure to passive smoke.</p> <p>The University prohibits smoking:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At all times in all University buildings, vehicles and enclosed areas (areas that are substantially enclosed by a roof and walls) <p>Within 3 metres of university building entrances, air inlets and windows.</p> <p>An exception to this policy is in rooms where smoking is part of bona fide research.</p> <p>All staff and students are required to comply with the University Smoking Policy and are advised that any breaches of this policy will be dealt with under the University's disciplinary regulations.</p>
