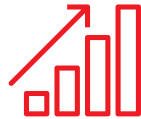

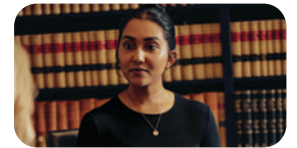

PURPOSE-BUILT LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS

At La Trobe, we're serious about preparing our students for the real world. Our purpose-built facilities and clinical teaching mean that no matter what you study, you'll get hands-on with honing your skills before going out into placements, internships and the workplace.

Our learning facilities include a moot court, dedicated newsroom and broadcasting equipment, state-of-the-art engineering and technology facilities, simulation labs, finance trading rooms, and more.

WORLD-CLASS HEALTH AND SCIENCE FACILITIES

We've invested \$500 million in our health and science learning facilities to ensure our students and researchers have the tools they need to make a real impact.

You'll be studying in upgraded specialist healthcare facilities, such as our recently expanded nursing simulation suites, the newly launched high-tech glasshouse, modern labs, a Paramedicine Practical Laboratory and much more.

RESEARCH AND INNOVATION PRECINCT

Our Research and Innovation Precinct connects students, researchers and private industry to co-create and develop innovative solutions for some of the biggest issues of our time.

The Precinct is home to the Digital Innovation Hub, Bio Innovation Hub and the Australian Food Innovation Centre.

SPORTS PARK

La Trobe Sports Park is the first of its kind in Australia. It offers a unique environment to play, teach and research sport. The Sports Park features a leading teaching and research facility and world-class sporting facilities to support major sports events, regular grassroots competitions and community opportunities. The Sports Park is a hub for professional sports franchises and visiting elite sports teams, boasting a FIFA-1 accredited football pitch, AFL oval, the Pavilion, and the La Trobe Sports Stadium. More recently, the La Trobe Sports Park has become the national base for Football Australia's national women's programs, including the Home of the Matildas, and the State Centres for Football Victoria and Rugby Victoria.

WORK-BASED LEARNING

During some courses, you will have the opportunity to participate in a work-based learning (WBL) placement, designed to allow you to extend your formal learning beyond the classroom.

WBL provides the opportunity to take your learning into a workplace and test your knowledge in a professional, real-world environment. Some courses include compulsory WBL subjects, but we also offer a range of elective WBL subjects, both cross-discipline and subject-specific.

We'll source placements for some subjects on your behalf, while others require you to source your own. If you're required to source your own, our staff will support you through the process. Students undertaking placements regionally are also eligible to access additional support under the Regional Reward program.

INDUSTRY PLACEMENTS

COMPULSORY PLACEMENT SUBJECTS

Depending on your course, you may be required to undertake compulsory professional placements as part of your studies. This could be clinical or professional education in the form of placements, work-integrated learning, fieldwork and other clinical and professional experience. These subjects are compulsory and required in order to gain professional registration.

ELECTIVE INDUSTRY PLACEMENTS

We have a range of elective opportunities to gain work-relevant experience for academic credit with our network of industry and community partners.

La Trobe offers a range of university-wide elective placement subjects, allowing eligible students, who don't have a compulsory placement subject in their course or those wanting to do an additional placement, to complete 100-400 hours of supervised, academically-supported placements.

We know nothing beats real-world, practical experience. Unlike other unis with a more theoretical approach, we want you to learn the useful stuff employers are looking for.

That's why we've got you covered with work-integrated learning and industry placement options embedded across many of our degrees, giving you the flexibility to get hands-on experience while balancing study, work and life commitments.

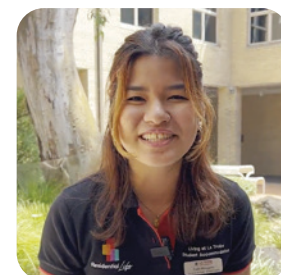

PATHWAYS INTO LA TROBE

Undergraduate pathways

Do you need help to meet the academic entry requirements for your preferred undergraduate course? LTCA offers foundation studies and Diploma programs to prepare you for undergraduate study.

These programs provide pathways to a broad range of undergraduate courses.

The foundation studies programs are equivalent to an Australian secondary school qualification and prepare you to enter the first year of your course. The Diploma programs help you transition into the second year.

Postgraduate pathways

Want to study a Master's degree but don't meet the academic and/or English requirements? Our Postgraduate Enabling Program (PEP) provides a pathway into a wide range of our Master's courses.

ENGLISH TUITION

Don't meet the language requirements of your preferred course? Study English on-campus in Sydney or Melbourne with LTCA, then progress directly to your pathway or La Trobe course.

ARTICULATION ARRANGEMENTS

Completing one of the approved articulation courses with a partner institution means that when you enter an eligible La Trobe course, you could receive credit for your previous studies (also known as 'advanced standing').

You may also be entitled to two awards when you graduate – one from us, and one from your home institution. Certain pathways may have additional requirements or restrictions that affect admission into our degrees, or the credit you're awarded upon admission, or your progression within the degree.

LA TROBE COLLEGE AUSTRALIA

You can do pathway programs in business, bioscience, engineering, health sciences, IT, media and communication and psychology, through our on-campus partner La Trobe College Australia (LTCA).

You'll study at our Melbourne or Sydney Campuses, so you'll be immersed in the university experience from day one. You'll be supported by expert teachers who understand the unique needs of international students and can help prepare you to progress into university studies.

Enjoy access to free services including one-on-one tutoring and English improvement sessions.

With programs that range in length from 10-week blocks to 12 months, LTCA is helping thousands of international students like you gain access to La Trobe University.
